Atlanta foodies looking for innovation and creativity can head to Chattanooga Thursday, June 10, through Saturday, June 12, for the Crafted by Southern Hands event. Just 90 minutes north of Atlanta, downtown Chattanooga's Warehouse Row will host a prominent group of Southern innovators, including the renowned country farmstead Blackberry Farm and sustainable designer Alabama Chanin.

Among the historic buildings and artisan boutiques, [Blackberry Farm](#) proprietor Sam Beall will lead a cooking demonstration, seed talk and cookbook signing. Additional highlights will include the lifestyle and design experts from sustainable clothing and home goods store [Alabama Chanin](#), clothing from [Billy Reid](#), and artist Lisa Norris of [Made by One Girl](#).

Located in the Great Smoky Mountains just outside of Knoxville, Tenn., Blackberry Farm has established itself as an institution for Southern culture, food and wine. Sample the Blackberry Farm experience during the event with the following:

- Flavorful gourmet products direct from Blackberry Farm, including a variety of jams, jellies, preserves, pickled products, cheese, salumis, grains and nuts and biscuit and fried chicken mixes.

- An introduction to Blackberry Farm featuring a cookbook discussion, live cooking demonstration by proprietor Sam Beall and seed talk by a resident gardener – Saturday, June 12 from 2 to 3 p.m.

- A book signing event with Sam Beall, author of The Blackberry Farm Cookbook – Saturday, June 12 from 3 to 4 p.m.
